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# Southwest Symposium Thrombosis

## Course Objectives

This symposium is intended for physicians, pharmacists, nurse practitioners, physician assistants, nurses and allied healthcare professionals, who provide care to patients with thrombotic and hemorrhagic diseases. The conference is pertinent to healthcare providers who care for patients on anticoagulants such as Warfarin, low molecular weight Heparin, the Pentasaccharide, aspirin and other antithrombotic agents. In addition the topics hold special interest for healthcare providers of patients with bleeding disorders such as hemophilia and von Willebrand's disease who receive clotting factor concentrates, recombinant factor, activated recombinant factor VII and DDAVP.

Participants who attend this course should be able to:

- Understand the latest published evidence relevant to the prophylaxis and treatment of patients with thrombosis in cancer patients;
- Become aware of recently published, potentially practice-changing information relevant to the diagnosis, treatment or prevention of venous and arterial thromboembolic disease;
- Understand current controversial issues related to VTE Prophylaxis and recommended approaches to these issues;
- Become familiar with new, evidence-based recommendations for the treatment of thrombosis according to the 8th Edition ACCP Guidelines;
- Review new developments in stroke prevention for atrial fibrillation;
- Review the evaluation and treatment of unusual thrombotic presentations;
- Become familiar with new and future anticoagulants and understand their impact on hospital and clinic practice; and
- Familiarize themselves evidence-based recommendations for the treatment of von Willebrand's disease and hemophilia according to the NHLBI, WFH and NHF guidelines.

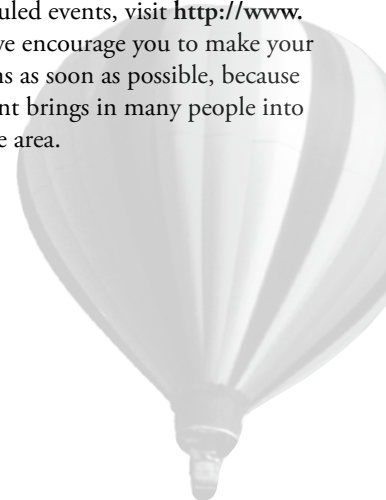
